

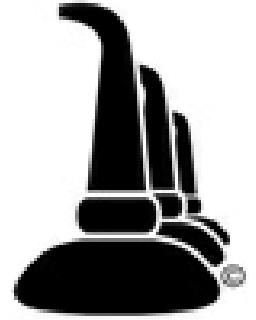

NOSE.... Medium-bodied, custard, vanilla, a little citrus note; water brings out the fruit - apple and lime with little notes of hessian and nutmeg

PALATE.... Medium-bodied, medium-dry with a little note of spicy ginger and, strangely, some almost tarry smoke notes of which there was no hint on the nose

FINISH.... Long, with gently chewy tannins, a reprise of the custard - even custard cream biscuits, some crème brulée and latte coffee
