COLOUR.... Very pale straw with pale yellow highlights .....

NOSE.... Medium-bodied, smoky with charred oak and medium depth of peat; water brings out a sweet note and delicate citrus - lime and apricots .....

PALATE.... Medium-dry, quite malty, of good body with sweet, rich vanilla which gradually opens out, supported by a pleasant peat note .....

FINISH.... Long, clean, quite complex and rich with smoky chocolate and spice notes, it finishes dry .....

NOTES..... D.o.b. Matured in ex-Bourbon casks. Very impressive, with the peat well-integrated as a supporting act, the sweetness is pleasant, doesn't jar with the peat and grows in the palate .....
