COLOUR.... Mid-amber with old gold highlights

NOSE.... Rich and honeyed with notes of citrus, lime, sherbet and a hint of peat; with water, it becomes more solid, with a malty character, some grassy/hay and tea notes

PALATE.... Rich, quite full-bodied, medium-sweet and round with a little edge of spicy gingerbread , some leather and a touch of cocoa peat

FINISH.... Long, with a good smoky middle, a little honeycomb, cinnamon and a grapey note.

NOTES.... Stronachie was a distillery located in Forgardenny, Perthshire which was built around 1900 and ceased production in 1928. Dewar Rattray were agents for the distillery's make and they resurrected the brand name with this single malt, whose whisky comes from Benrinnes.
